

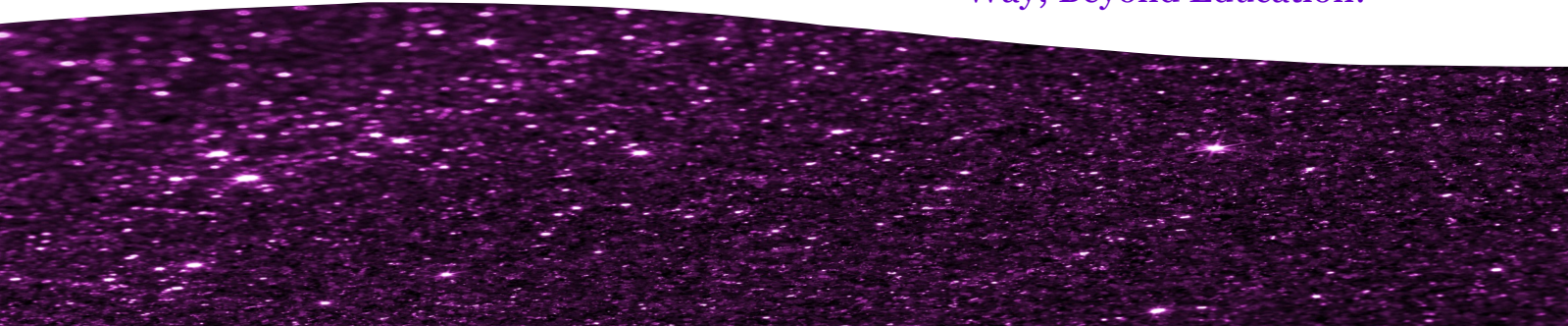



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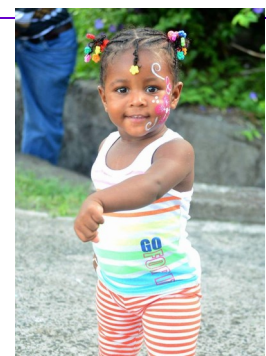


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About

Founded in 2014, The Mt. Rose Project Inc. is a Registered, Non-Political, Non-Profit organization located in the village of Mt. Rose, in the historic Parish of St. Patrick, on the island of Grenada. The Organization was created to brighten the lives of children within the community in order for them to achieve their highest potential. The organization believes that every child despite their family's socio economic status, should enjoy all that life has to offer, with this in mind, the organization was proud to host the first ever Back-To-School Fun-Day in the community on Sunday August 24, 2014. Children who attended the event, enjoyed an evening of unlimited access to bouncy castles, face painting, games, music and refreshment. Through the generosity of our sponsors both at home and abroad, we were able to distribute over two hundred packages containing school supplies to the children who attended the event. Now in existence for six years the organization continue to expand its programs and offering to the community

Programs

Back-To-School Program

"Education is the most powerful weapon which we can use to change the world." ~Mandela,1990. Our Back-To-School program is our initiative to provide a day of free fun activity including a bouncy house, face painting, trampoline and cricket games to the children in the community. Every child in attendance will receive a package with school supplies at the end of the day. Our Back-To-School program was launched on August 24th, 2014, the organization was proud to host the first ever 'Back to School Fun Day' for the community. This program is the organization longest running program.



Summer Challenger Wall

Launched in 2020, Summer Challenge Wall is our initiative geared towards encouraging students to master and excel in some of the core requirements (Math, English & Technology) needed to succeed. In addition, this initiative gives children who do not reside in the community of Mt. Rose, the opportunity to receive supplies from the organization.

Math Month

The organization is proud to be the sponsor of Math Month at the GSDACS. This program is hosted by Mr. Kyron DeCoteau who is the head of the Math and Science Department at the school. Mr DeCoteau is also the Operation Director of the organization. For the entire month of February student take part in Math-Centric challenges and activity. At the end of the month the students are rewarded with prizes ranging from Scientific Calculators, Geometry Sets, Flash Drive, School Bags, Notebook and other School Supplies.

Technology Initiative

This is our Initiative to bridge the technology gap in our community and schools by providing tablets and other technologies, ranging from projectors, computers and computer classes to the students, schools and members in the community.

Tablet Initiative

The organization launched its Tablet Initiative in 2017. This initiative is geared towards providing tablets to students in order to enhance their academic performance and community services. In 2018 the organization presented 5 Lenovo A7-30 Tablets each valued at £74.00



Projector Initiative

The organization launched its Projector Initiative in 2018, when it donated an Epson Pro EX9220 1080p+ WU-XGA 3,600 lumens color brightness (color light output) 3,600 lumens white brightness (white light output) wireless Miracast HDMI MHL 3LCD projector, valued at \$729.00usd to The Grenada Seventh-day Adventist Comprehensive School



Technology Class

During the months of February to April 2015, the organization conducted a FREE Introduction to Computer and Introduction to the Internet course in the community of Mt. Rose In an effort to bridge the technology gap! The class was held at the Grenada SDA Comprehensive school and was conducted by a member of the organization along with the assistant of three students volunteer from the GSDACS! At the end of the program the organization was able to assist one of the student volunteers to purchase a brand new Asus - 15.6" Laptop - Intel Core i5 - 6GB



Project Restoration: The Mt. Rose Seventh-day Adventist Elementary School

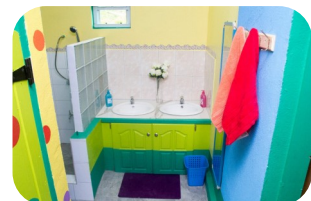
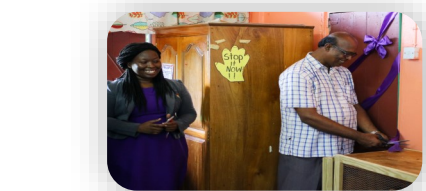
During the month of April 2018, our Co-Executive Director Mr. Don Simon and our Programs Director, Ms. Asha Mc Ewen made a visit to The Mt. Rose SDA Elementary School, and a tour of the facility was given by the then acting principal Mr. Bayne Vincent. During the visit it was observed that the school had not been receiving adequate repairs over the years, and the conditions the students are made to study under were unacceptable. Following the visit the principal discussed what the school was in need of as it relates to renovation especially the preschool classroom and bathroom. Over the past few years the school has been facing low student enrollment numbers, which is considered a serious existential crisis that can threaten the school's continued existence. There has been a 50% drop in enrollment over the past few years and because of this the school cannot meet the necessary requirements in order to qualify to receive available aid and/or grants from organizations that are willing to assist schools on the island.

For more than fifty years The Mt. Rose Seventh-day Adventist Elementary School has served as the only elementary school in our community and has been the foundation school for many doctors, lawyers and other professionals. It is our hope that the school continues to exist long after we are gone, so that the children in our community can continue to benefit from the same foundation that has molded us into the people we are today. Your donation will help us get one step closer to our goal of ensuring that the children in our community learn in an environment that will promote their physical, emotional, social and cognitive wellbeing. Project Restoration is our initiative geared towards restoring and preserving our community's elementary school.

In August of 2018, the organization embarked on phase one of Project Restoration with a complete renovation and extension of the preschool classroom bathroom, which was closed for over 10 years. Work completed was valued at over \$25,000ec.

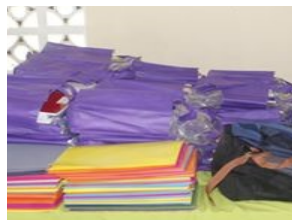
Christmas Program-Retired Program
